



UPDATE FOR THE 2020-21 SCHOOL YEAR

DUAL LANGUAGE COMPREHENSIVE DISTANCE LEARNING PLAN

The Redmond School District (RSD) is committed to maintaining the integrity of its 50/50 dual language (DL) education model, which includes direct language modeling, authentic language interactions and cross cultural experiences. The following information outlines the district's DL program commitment as it relates to the time in which instruction is delivered through the Comprehensive Distance Learning model:

◆ TEACHERS & STAFF

- All RSD DL classes will be taught by a licensed bilingual teacher with support as needed from bilingual instructional assistants.

◆ CURRICULUM & INSTRUCTION

- RSD will continue to support the DL program model; including the use of state and district approved curriculum, teaching to state standards, and allocating half the core instruction to Spanish and half to English. See [Dual Language Program Details](#) for more information.
- Comprehensive Distance Learning in the DL program will follow the same state/district guidelines as English-only Comprehensive Distance Learning.
